THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE FILING BANKRUPTCY



- File your taxes
- Meet with multiple attorneys
- 4 Avoid making large transfers
- Review your Credit Report

KNOWYOUR BUDGET

Review your **bank statements** & regular **bills** so you have an idea of your monthly income and expenses

FILE YOUR TAXES

The Bankruptcy Court requires that you have all your taxes filed prior to filing.

Bonus: Any taxes you owe can be handled in your bankruptcy case!

MEET WITH MULTIPLE ATTORNEYS

This is **your** case and **your** money, make sure you find someone who is the **best fit** for your situation.

AVOID LARGE TRANSFERS

A Bankruptcy Trustee may review your bank statements after your case is filed.

Large transfers or gifts right before filing could complicate your case.

REVIEW YOUR CREDIT REPORT

This helps get an accurate picture of all your **debt**. It may affect which Bankruptcy Chapter you choose to file.
